

## Rainy Day Guidelines

A modified version of the President's Message from the March 2014 *Knapsack* regarding the responsibilities of the hike leader and hikers when it's raining on a hike day or it has rained and trails have been impacted:



The Board...makes the following recommendations.

When the meeting place for the hike is accessible by public transportation, the leader will be there. Those who arrive can decide, with the leader, if the hike is possible or if an alternative would be better. When the hike is dependent on car pools or car shuttles and the leader decides to change or cancel the hike, the leader is responsible for getting in touch with all who called to say they were coming, either to the meeting place or trailhead. In order to make this possible, the Membership Secretary will email or mail a roster to all leaders so email addresses and telephone numbers of hikers will be readily available to the leader. The hiker also has a responsibility to call the leader, before 7:00 AM
