Selected Guidelines: LEADERS: Appoint a rear leader; wait at intersections for all to catch up. If you cancel or change your hike, please inform hike coordinators Jim Baranowski or Marilyn Vihman so the change can be communicated to all members. HIKERS: Let the leader lead. Report to leader if dropping out before end of hike. EVERYONE: Bring water & drink it. Bring lunch unless stated otherwise. Sticks & boots advised on hilly trails. Some hikes may not need a reservation, but if a reservation is requested, please contact the hike leader. INCIDENTS: It is good to carry a first aid kit with you in case someone is injured. Submit a filled-out Incident Form available from the hike leader or the club website. CARPOOLING: Carpooling is back. Be prepared to wear a mask if requested. Discuss with the hike leader when signing up. **New suggested rate** for the entire car is **67** cents per mile plus share of bridge tolls & entrance fees. For example, 2 persons including driver: **\$.34/mile**, 3 pers: **\$.23/mi**, 4 pers: **\$.17/mi**, 5 pers: **\$.14/mi**.

For most agencies, call 511 & state agency for which you need information.

Please carefully note the starting times. If transferring from BART to a bus or other public transit, the time given is the departure of the bus, etc. Please allow at least 15 minutes to get from the BART train to the other transportation.
